

Form Questions for April 10th GRADE-LESS REPORTING FORUM

Four individuals emailed in questions and/or comments. We divided the questions up into two categories: Process/Practice and Philosophical.

Process/Practice Questions

- 1. What "text" or written comments can I expect in reporting?
- 2. If I request grades, how many times a year will I get them?
- 3. How many Parent/Teacher conferences will there be each year?
- 4. Are student records being kept up to date and how do parents attain them if families move out of the school district, province, or country?
- 5. What is the transition process from Grade 9 to Grade 10?
- 6. Directed to the teachers. How much time did it take to do this kind of reporting this term? How does this compare to the time it took in term I?
- 7. Why was there no written feedback supplied with the letter grades when requested by parents?
- 8. Can we have formalized report card each term with feedback in all subject areas, both verbally (parent/teacher conference) and written (report card) and then have the option of letter grades or no letter grades?

Philosophical Questions

- 1. Is grade-less reporting the way SD 48 will operate in the future? Is this a Pilot Project?
- 2. How will the Grade-less Pilot Project be evaluated?
- 3. Please clarify if this is a Grade-less or a Report-less Pilot. Many parents were expecting to get a report card very similar to Term I, simply without the letter grades, and that was not the case.
- 4. How are you "quantifying" intermediate learning in preparation for high school?
- 5. Can you provide the philosophical background, rationale, or reasoning for grade-less reporting.
