

Place your orders for the current session (make sure that you hit "update order and proceed" at the bottom of the form after selecting menu items for each lunch). **Also, please DO NOT leave an order in the system that you ultimately do not want. If you make a mistake or do not wish to order an item or an entire lunch, go back into the menu and unselect the items, otherwise it will remain in our system and your order will be processed, and you will be charged appropriately.

The online system will not accommodate late orders. Online orders must be made online by credit card. We do not accept cheques.

As much as we would love to (and have in the past) accommodate everyone, there is a chain of events that happens after the deadline on:

Friday, April 7th at **NOON**

- 1. At 1pm (just 1 hour after the deadline) the orders get sent to suppliers so that they have enough time to arrange staff for the following week if necessary.
- 2. 14 delivery sheets (each class) get printed with each child's order and a summary for the entire school, primary classes and intermediate classes.
- 3. The information is then transferred onto new sheets in a bigger, more legible format for teachers, volunteers and distribution bags.
- 4. Sheets are delivered to teachers, the hot lunch room and put into the delivery bags.

As you can see, this is quite a process at the start of each session. One change (late order) affects all the steps and EVERYTHING has to be redone!
