The main goal is to teach students how to grow their own organic food, and to work together to plant, harvest, and prepare the food. Each class will have a garden box to maintain and share what they are growing. Look for the garlic and potatoes, which have already started to grow!

The garden project was made possible thanks to a **Toyota Evergreen School Ground Greening** grant to build the garden boxes, **Whistler Excavations** for the soil delivery, **West Coast Seeds** for a seed donation, **Rona**, **Sea to Sky Soils**, and **Kathleen Cunningham** for her donation of a wheelbarrow and shovels as well as the teachers, students and parents who helped to make this happen. The **Real Estate Association of Whistler** has just given MPCS a grant to build a circular cement pathway in the centre of the gardens, and we are seeking funding for a native plant garden.

MPCS PAC Executive is pleased to announce the following funding investments this school year, all of which will be summarized in our year end letter in June:


- Technology investment \$15,000
